A small capital project is defined as follows:

- A new construction, expansion, renovation, or replacement project for an existing facility or facilities. Project costs can include the cost of land, engineering, architectural planning, and contract services needed to complete the project, ie: community club, skating rink, swimming pool, additions or upgrades to an existing facility.
- The purchase of major equipment (assets) ie: ice resurfacer, commercial freezer/stove/refrigerator.
- A major maintenance or rehabilitation project for existing facilities, ie: new roof for a building, flooring in a community centre, or repair of water damage to a facility.
