SENIOR ENTERPRISE ARCHITECT

Reporting to the Vice President, Information Technology Services, the Senior Enterprise Architect serves as the organization's chief strategist for integrating leading technologies and business requirements to manage and direct the development of long-term technology plans and strategies for the entire organization, which support Manitoba Liquor & Lotteries' business plans, goals and objectives.

Duties:

- Meet with levels of business and technical groups to identify information technology strategies that support the Manitoba Liquor & Lotteries Strategic Plan.
- Identify impacts to technical strategies arising from changes in external technical and business environment (e.g. industry standards, regulations, mergers and acquisitions, trends).
- Utilize deep and wide technical knowledge base to lead the development of strategies that enable business to meet its strategic goals in an effective manner.
- Optimize within and between technology strategic plans to minimize impacts to the organization while maximizing benefits.
- Work with the Canadian Cross Jurisdictional Committee Enterprise Architecture (EA) group to advance organizational strategies and ensure organizational strategies are in alignment when appropriate.
- Support business strategic planning, and work to align enterprise architecture with the organization's annual Strategic Plan.
- Work to align enterprise architecture with other technology departments (e.g., Corporate Security, Corporate Production).
- Create and maintain a list of strategies and priorities, based on business needs.
- Oversee the development and maintenance of the Information Technology Services (ITS) five-year enterprise architecture strategic plan.
- Present on EA work products, standards, policies, and practices to corporate stakeholder groups, management and executive management.
- Participate in the development and evaluation of RFPs for strategic technology purchases.
- Guide and oversee development, deployment and communication of EA Governance processes. Ensure EA practices are in alignment with TOGAF (The Open Group Architecture Framework). Recommend changes to improve EA practices.
- Guide and oversee development of EA standards and principles across the organization, and within EA domains (e.g., networks, applications, information security, management, etc.)
- Identify and report EA violations to the Director, Enterprise Architecture.
- Guide and mentor Architects and subject matter experts to ensure quality architecture in projects and strategies.
- Oversee annual architectural maturity assessments.
- Oversee deployment and maintenance of EA repository and tool-set.
- Review new and existing program/project architectures for compliance with the Enterprise Architecture.
- Review IT procurement plans for compliance with EA Standards and architectural strategies.
- Document exceptions to EA Standards.
- Ensure project documentation captures significant architectural decisions.
- Identify architectural risks and propose alternatives and solutions.
- Create enterprise architecture strategies as assigned.
- Create enterprise project architecture as assigned.
- Research a range of technology options to serve identified business strategies.
- Identify most appropriate technology solutions for the organization 's business needs.
- Keep up-to-date with industry regulations, standards, trends, best practices, and emerging technologies by attending conferences/seminars, regularly reviewing industry publications, books, internet resources, etc.
- Develop position statements on the internal use of technology solutions.
- Research a range of technology options to serve identified business strategies.
- Identify most appropriate technology solutions for the organization 's business needs.
- Develop position statements on the internal use of technology solutions.

Primary Qualifications:

- Completion of a recognized degree or diploma in a related IT discipline.
- A minimum of ten years Information Technology related experience.
- A minimum of three years demonstrated performance in Architecture.
- Broad knowledge of complex and leading edge technology solutions at the enterprise level and specific applications for discipline specific requirements coupled with a knowledge of MBLL's core businesses and support functions.
- Strong analytical and organizational skills.
- The ability to work in a team environment.
- In-depth knowledge of IT industry best practices, technologies, architectures, and emerging technologies across all IT domains (networking, servers, storage, application platforms, applications, software development tools and techniques, databases, internet, etc.).
- Business analysis skills (requirements gathering, modelling, etc.).
- Track industry and regulatory standards relevant to business (e.g. LGA, Gaming Standards Association, Gaming Labs International, Payment Card Industry).
- Continuous upgrading/learning is required to remain current in information technology.
- Lifelong learning, in developing innovative ways of acquiring and transferring knowledge in complex circumstances.

Secondary Qualifications:

- Industry credentials in Architecture Frameworks are considered an asset.
- Project Management training is an asset.
