Reporting to the Manager, Information Security, the summer student will be working closely with various areas within the Information Security department.

Duties:

- Security Information Event Management (SIEM) – Project to line up the current SIEM event log analysis and alerting to replicate other capabilities from alternate threat analytics. Involves understanding of relevant event logs and processes to aggregate events, generate queries, produce dashboards and define thresholds for triggering events.
- Patch and vulnerability management. Improve our processes, documentation and execution for enterprise asset visibility, asset identification, detection, and remediation of identified vulnerabilities to secure our endpoints.
- Assist in other duties as assigned.

Primary Qualifications:

- U of W or U of M – Network Security Diploma
- Information Security knowledge
- Familiarity and experience with query languages, regular expressions, etc.
- Understanding of security principles and risk management. The ability to analyze malware, test for vulnerabilities and assist in responding to security incidents.
